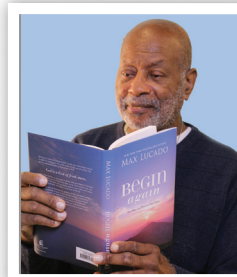
### MEN'S RESIDENT SHELTER

### FAMILY C.A.R.E. PROGRAM

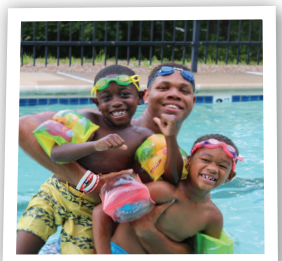
The Family C.A.R.E. Program provides much needed food and household goods for impoverished men, women and children.

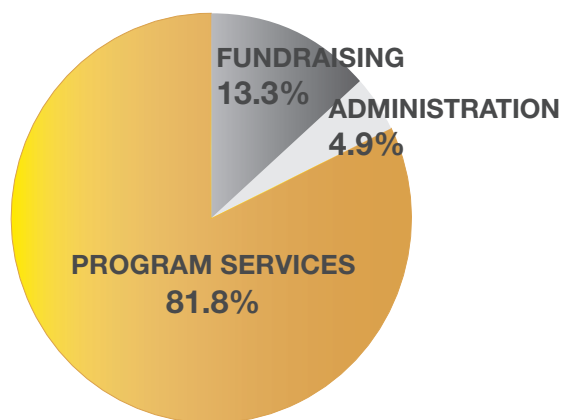
